

White Wine

Pinot Grigio, Cosmina - Viile Timis, Romania 2018

A Pinot Grigio with more tropical fruit and character than some of its Italian counterparts; the Romans started making fine wine here over 2000 years ago on hills overlooking the Black Sea. Lovely, yet opulent aromas of grapefruit and peach, offers the palate a wealth of refreshing citrus acidity.

Chardonnay, Five Foot Track - Australia 2017

While the term autumnal is-usually reserved for those rich reds, why not try this soft and rounded white, with the characteristics of cooked apple and underlying hints of vanilla.

Chardonnay, Macon-Lugny - Les Charmes, France 2017

The very old vines grown in the historic "les Charmes" vineyard give this lovely Chardonnay from southern Burgundy especially fine flavours and finesse. Fresh citrus aromas lead to a creamy palate and an elegant fruity finish.

Sauvignon-Blanc, Airen, Verdejo - El Moturo, Spain 2018

Intense and expressive combination of grassy and gooseberry aromas compliments this Sauvignon Blanc grape, blended with notes of fennel and white pepper from the Verdejo. Concentrated and textured on the palate, with depth and a persistent mineral finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, The Ned - Marlborough, New Zealand 2018

This is a single vineyard Sauvignon from the highly rated winemaker Brent Marris. Zesty and fruity with a brilliant smoky herbal twist, this delicious fresh white has characteristic lime and gooseberry.

Picpoul de Pinet, Plo d'Isabelle - Languedoc, France 2018

Rose Wine

Berry Bros. Reserve Rose - Collovray & Terrier, Southern France 2018

Pale pink in colour, this reserve rose offers a youthful red-fruit aromas of wild raspberries and pink grapefruit. A blend of greancahe, cinsault and syrah, it combines vibrant red-berry fruit with intense spicy notes layering complexity.

Zinfandel Rose - Blushmore, Puglia, Italy 2017

A fantastic example of an off dry, easy drinking wine full of summer fruit flavours with a hint of sweetness. This welcoming, Vegan friendly, wine can be enjoyed throughout the evening.

Red Wine

Merlot, Vina Carrasco - Valle Central, Chile 2018

Made by Chile's most famous Welshman, Luis Felipe Edwards, Vegan friendly offering, has a good concentration and depth of fruit, with a soft and plummy texture, undernoted with hints of vanilla.

Shiraz, Under the Sycamore - Australia 2017

Sometime the simplest of blends can make for the most extravagant of wines. This Shiraz, a Silky smooth texture, offers lashings of blackcurrant, bramble and white pepper flavours.

Primitivo, Oltre Passo - Italy 2017

A mouth coating, Vegan friendly, chocolatey red wine; flavours of dried prune, date and plump cherry, with swathes of sweet spice, offers an old world alternative to Shiraz and Pinot Noir.

Malbec, Trivento - Mendoza, Argentina 2018

This deep purple wine, perfect with grilled meats or rich pasta dishes, combines flavours of black fruit, blueberries and plums with notes of pepper and dark chocolate. A smooth rich wine, with great balance and a long elegant finish.

Malbec, Beaute de Sud - South of France 2017

A robust, autumnal feeling wine blended from Blackberries, plums and blueberries, accompanied by a subtle touch of spice. This Juicy, smooth and weighty palate, is a quality classic from the region that gave the original vine for this Chilean, and Argentina wine.

Navarra, Vina del Perdon Reserva - Spain 2015

This reserva offering, is a blend of 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Sauvignon. It has been aged in American and French oak barriques for 24 months resulting in a complex wine full of with aromas. Navara, is a superb value aged alternative to neighbouring Rioja. With a great structure of spices, minerals and vanilla, providing a long finishing flavour.

Domaine de la Bastide - Cote du Rhone, France 2018

Aromas of red berries and hints of rosemary, thyme and lavender that grow in abundance in this area of the Rhone. The estate is located in the village of Visan and has a long history of making superb wines. It was the Knights Templar who first established the vineyards on the property before it became a Benedictine, then a Dominican monastery. From this age old blending, you can expect ripe bramble fruit and hints of black cherry together with pepper and spice on the finish.

Blason du Rhone- Chateauneuf du Pape, France 2016

A classic quality French red, blended from ripe cherry and berry flavours with a layer of gentle, warming spices behind, makes this exceptional value, vegan friendly, a great offering from a top producer.

Chateau Lagrange - St Julien, France 2005

A grand cru classic from the decade's best vintage, stored en premier and recently released. The yields from this vineyard are a lowly 40hl/ha, which bestows great concentration. The keynote here is incredible ripeness. The attractive nose is elegant and pretty, while the wine itself is pure and generous with polished blackberry.

Sweet Wine

Botrytis Semillon, de Bartoli - NSW Australia 2014

A light golden dessert wine offering a rich blend of stone fruits and citrus on the nose, which reveals loads of power in a rich vibrant wine. With sweet vanilla oak and spiciness – you can experience the trademark of botrytized, late harvest wines.

Sparkling

Prosecco, Tallero - Treviso, Italy

Elegant and seductive on the nose, with a delicate bouquet of apples, grapes, peach, and citrus blossoms

Prosecco Superiore, Valdo - Valdobbiadene, Veneto, Italy

This extra dry fine wine is of a superior quality as it comes from a specially defined inner hilly region in the DOCG North East of Venice. Less fruit per vine gives more intensity and complexity whilst retaining all the delicious aromatic and fruity charms.
